

WORMLEYSBURG BOROUGH COUNCIL'S ADMINISTRATION COMMITTEE
MINUTES
AUGUST 25, 2016

The meeting was called to order at 1:00 a.m. by Chairman Hawbecker with the following members present: Mr. Hawbecker, Mr. Deklinski and Ms. Stuski. Also present were Mr. Berresford, Borough Manager, and Rob Kole from Benefit Connections.

Ms. Stuski discussed the hostile work environment that was created by our public works laborers against our summer helper. Ms. Stuski wanted to advertise the jobs for new employees. After some discussion it was decided to recommend adding a section to the Policy Manual and meet with the laborers on what happened and what will happen if it ever happens again.

Rob Kole, our medical benefits broker, showed the committee his report on the employee medical insurance for the period October 1, 2016 to September 30, 2017. Our current policy renewal increase is 10.9%. The committee discussed other options like an HMO (5.7% increase), joining the Pinnacle Network (3.9% decrease) and increasing deductibles. Mr. Berresford stated he felt budgeted costs will not increase even with the 10.9% increase. Motion by Mr. Deklinski, seconded by Ms. Stuski to recommend renewal of the current policy with Capital Blue Cross. Motion carried unanimously.

There being no further business the meeting was adjourned at 10:40 a.m.
