**Motion:**

Commissioner Preble made a motion to approve the January 2017 Treasurer’s Report and to submit it for audit, seconded by Commissioner Beasley. The motion passed unanimously.

He also stated he went to three PR events, which involved taking Max to meet owners of the businesses that donated to the K9 fund.

Chief Hope reported that Detective Friel gave a presentation this morning to the Lemoyne Business Association regarding active shooter situations. Mayor Gallo stated that the presentation was well done and very detailed.

Chief Hope also mentioned to the Committee that Officer Mauchamer, during a recent fire call, kicked the door in of a burning building and dragged a man out of the building who was calling for help. Chief Hope stated that in a future meeting they will recognize Officer Mauchamer and Corporal Hair for their service.
