CALL TO ORDER:

The Monthly Business Meeting of the West Shore Regional Police Department Commission was held at 510 Herman Ave, Lemoyne, PA and called to order at 5:00 p.m. by Chairman Martini with Commissioner Preble leading the Pledge of Allegiance.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

Motion:

Commissioner Candioto made a motion to approve the Minutes of the May 10, 2017 Monthly Business Meeting that were previously distributed, seconded by Commissioner Preble. The motion passed unanimously.

CITIZENS/VISITORS:

Lieutenant Friel, Officer Conroy and Officer Stolley were present.

CHAIRMAN’S ANNOUNCEMENTS:

Commissioner Martini thanked the officers for all the work they do for both boroughs.

TREASURER’S REPORT:

Commissioner Preble reported balances of \$345,373.83 in the checking account, \$279,443.55 in the Capital Reserve Fund, \$11,451.47 in the donation checking account and \$15,511.28 in the K9 donation account as of May 31, 2017.

Motion:

Commissioner Preble made a motion to approve the May 2017 Treasurer’s Report and to submit it for audit, seconded by Commissioner Beasley. The motion passed unanimously.

Chief Hope reported that the audit results were in and they were good. He ordered a bound copy for each Commissioners so they can review it.

Chief Hope informed the Commission about the Buckle Up Grant Detail that ran from May 15th thru June 3rd. He stated the officers did 41 hours of grant work with 50 car stops of which 6 drivers were not wearing seatbelts.

Officer Conroy reported that he and K9 Max had 5 K9 assist calls outside of the jurisdiction and 4 K9 assist calls inside the jurisdiction in May. 3 calls were for drugs, 3 calls were to clear buildings, and 3 were for searches. Officer Conroy and K9 Max also did a foot patrol at the Greek Festival.

OLD BUSINESS:

Commissioner Preble questioned the Chief about the Use of Force Training Simulator and when it would be open for officials to view. Chief Hope stated that Lower Allen was currently working on scheduling such visits and would inform the Commission as soon as he receives the dates.

The public meeting was reconvened at 5:30 pm.


NEXT COMMISSION MEETING:
