

WORMLEYSBURG BOROUGH COUNCIL'S STREETS AND SANIATRY AFFAIRS
COMMITTEE
MINUTES
JANUARY 31, 20117

The meeting was called to order at 11:00 a.m. by Chairman Deklinski with the following members present: Mr. Deklinski and Ms. Stuski. Also present was Mr. Berresford, Borough Manager, and David Spiroff, Public Works Foreman.

The Committee discussed the 2017 Streets Program. After much discussion the Committee decided to recommend the following streets for paving to Council. East Crestwood Drive (West Crestwood Drive to the bend); Echo Road (Rupley Road to the Borough/Township Line); Chestnut Street (Front Street to Second Street) and Rupley Road (Yverdon Drive to Grant Drive). The Committee also requested Mr. Berresford obtain a quote for the storm sewer line replacements at Hillside Drive and Hillside Circle.

Mr. Berresford reviewed the following items with the Committee:

- Elm Street and River Street ADA Curb Ramp Project.
- The Walnut Storm Sewer Project.
- The traffic signal controllers beginning to fail.
- The conversion to LED Street Lights.
- The replacement of the two (2) pumps at Pump Station 2 within the next several years.
- The need to replace the covering on the salt shed due to wind damage.

The Committee took up the subject of redesignation of our \$68,750.00 CDBG Grant award. After much discussion the Committee plans to offer the following items to do with this grant funding:

- Do ADA improvements at several intersections downtown.
- Do ADA upgrades to the parks.
- Start a \$30,000.00 grant program to low income home owners in conjunction with New Hope Ministries.

There being no further business the meeting was adjourned at 12:18 p.m.
