

**Borough of Wormleysburg**  
**RECREATION BOARD MEETING**  
**Tues., 3/1/16**

Members Present: Linda Fraver, George Kahler, Adam Nelson, Sue Stuart

Excused: Margie Stuski, Arreanne Redding

1. The meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m. in Borough Council Chambers by Ms. Stuart, acting in the absence of Ms. Stuski. The minutes from the 1/5/16 meeting were approved by unanimous consent.
2. On motion made by Mr. Kahler and seconded by Ms. Fraver, the Rec Board unanimously approved the purchase of a suit appropriate for the Easter Bunny. Estimated price was \$100.
3. Mr. Deklinski presented a proposed discounted pricing structure for Redding Field to encourage use by baseball and softball teams. The group discussed the pricing, including pros and cons of offering discounts. On motion made by Mr. Kahler and seconded by Mr. Nelson, members unanimously approved the following discount pricing for the summer of 2016. The impact of pricing will be reviewed at year-end to assure that it covers maintenance costs and determine if it will continue. All prices exclude electric use for evening lighting.
  - a. One-day use: \$50
  - b. Two days: \$75
  - c. Five days (one week): \$150; multiple weeks to be charged at the weekly rateThe revised pricing will be shared with Borough Council at the next meeting.
4. The Board also proposed further renovations and upgrades at Redding Park, including removing the tennis courts and replacing them with a multi-use surface, repairing the press box, plumbing upgrades, and rewiring the park to enhance electrical service throughout. Mr. Kahler and Mr. Deklinski will estimate costs for these updates for a future meeting.
5. Plans for the Easter Egg Hunt were discussed, including a few revisions to the draft flyer. We still need to purchase prizes for the three age categories (0-3, 4-8, 9-12) and giveaways for the kids. Ms. Stuart will revise the flyer and forward to the Borough Office for the school.
6. River Day will be changed from 7/16/16 to 6/18/16 from 12 Noon to 3 PM.
  - a. Ms. Nelson spoke with the Mayor about closing the street and the application was recently sent to Penn DOT.
  - b. Mr. Nelson will schedule a working session before the next meeting to discuss event details.
7. The next meeting is scheduled for Tues., 4/5/2/16.
8. The meeting adjourned at 8:30 p.m.
